

instructions

1. Print onto heavy paper (also called "card stock"). Kinkos makes great prints.
2. IN GENERAL: Score all fold lines and pre-fold all folds before gluing. Use common white glue, spread thinly, and pinch until it sticks. All tabs are assumed to be normal peak fold (unless shown otherwise.)
3. Cut out all of the parts. It is helpful to use a hobby knife and cutting mat (or other hard surface) for the small parts.
4. Starting at the back of the body, begin to glue the tabs. Work your way forward.
5. Build hood and attach to body.
5. Build chassis.
6. Build wheels (see papercruiser.com for a helpful video). Attach wheels to chassis.
7. Attach chassis to body, using alignment arrows. Start at front tab, let dry, then work towards the rear.
8. Cut out and build bumpers, Attach bumpers to body
9. Cut out and attach mirrors and other small parts
10. optional: with a matching-color marker, color the fold and cut lines for better appearance.v
